10 Steps to Map a Bible Verse

1. Begin with prayer.
2. Select your verse and write it down.
3. Use online tools to read the verse in different versions and pick 3 or 4 versions to write down.
4. Jot down any initial questions as they pop up.
5. Look up main words in an English dictionary.
(Even ones you think you know!)
6. Look up main words in a concordance like blueletterbible.com.
7. Write out the key themes you notice.
8. Answer these questions:
 - a. Who?
 - b. What?
 - c. When?
 - d. Where?
 - e. Why?
9. Look up cross-references.
10. Ask and apply:
 - a. What did I learn in this verse?
 - b. What did this verse teach me about God?
